

CattlActive® is an all-natural oral drench designed to neutralize excess rumen acid, support healthy gut microbe populations and increase absorption in calves and adult cattle.

Why Use CattlActive®?

CattlActive® helps balance the pH of the rumen, stimulating feed and water consumption. It also aids in the evacuation of harmful bacteria and microbes encountered in sale barns, calving grounds, and shipping facilities.

How do I use it?

• Give orally (with drench gun) during processing, re-vaccination and with sick treatment protocols. CattlActive® does not contradict or interfere with any de-wormer or antibiotic regimen.



• CattlActive® is safe for use in calves at birth and during the branding and pre-weaning stages. It should also be given to high-risk calves at processing, re-vaccination and completion of the preconditioning period.



 Use for feeder cattle while transitioning from growing rations, wheat pasture, or grass to higher concentrate rations.



• Can be used to ease the symptoms of bloat by reducing acid in the rumen.

What is in it?

Corn oil, glycerin, onion extract, orange peel bitters, guar gum, soybean oil, vegetable-based fatty acids, and mineral water.



Dosing Instructions for High-Risk Calves

The following dosage guidelines provide a comprehensive plan for most scenarios. If using **CattlActive**® RA in addition to the drench, please consult with a **CattlActive**® specialist to discuss modification of the following recommendations.

- At processing and revaccination:
 - o 200 to 300 lbs 10 ml
 - o 330 to 400 lbs 10 ml
 - o 400 to 600 lbs 15 ml
 - o 660 lbs and up 20 ml
- Sick treatment protocols: use dose as described above.
- Feeder cattle: for cattle transitioning from grass to higher concentrate rations, give 20 ml/head.
- For stressed cattle: add 1 ml/head/day in water for 3 5 days during high stress periods or to prepare calves for shipping
